STANDARDS FOR PROVIDERS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION

1. Educational workshop must relate to one or more of the 12 Core Functions of the Alcohol & Drug Counselor **or** one or more of the 5 Domains of the Clinical Supervisor.
2. At least one presenter *that is present during the entirety of the educational workshop* must hold a certification or licensure in a behavioral health field that grants an independent scope of practice in the State of Georgia (i.e., CADC-II, CAADC, LPC, LCSW, LMFT, Licensed PsyD, Physician with Board Certification in Psychiatry or Addiction Medicine) **and/or** hold a Doctorate degree in a behavioral health field (i.e., Clinical Psychology, Social Work, Professional Counseling, Marital & Family Therapy, Addiction Counseling/Studies) from a *regionally accredited* college or university.
3. A certificate must be awarded to participants and must state the number of hours approved by the ADACBGA, attendees full name, date, topic, and clearly indicate the ADACBGA provider number.
4. A list of participants in each educational workshop must be maintained for a minimum of three (3) years.
5. A sign-in sheet with signature of participants or another electronic means of verifying individualized participation in a workshop (i.e., login audit reports, proof of workshop completion tied to unique registration, etc.) must be maintained for a minimum of three (3) years.
6. A measurable evaluation must be given to participants and copies maintained for a minimum of three (3) years.
7. The workshop must have stated goals and objectives.
8. Educational providers must be able to make any or all of the above available to the ADACBGA within 24 business hours of a request, including proof of minimum credentials and/or formal education.
