Initial and Renewal Core Requirements and Policies for the Georgia Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor – Trainee (CADC-T)

Prerequisite formal education:	Minimum of High School Diploma or GED
A&D Education/12 Core Functions:	50 Contact Hours <i>6 of 50 in Professional Ethics of the A&D Counselor</i>
Direct Work Experience:	300 Clock Hours
Clinical Supervision:	30 Hours (25% must be one-on-one) with supervision spanning <i>not less than 6</i> of the 12 Core Functions of the A&D Counselor
Application Fee:	\$150.00
Examination Fee:	N/A
Examination Level:	N/A
Legal Scope of Practice:	No legal scope granted; May practice in a licensed agency and/or state-sponsored program under the ongoing clinical supervision of an ADACBGA CCS and/or a professional who has obtained the ADACBGA's Approved Clinical Supervisor (ACS) endorsement <i>only</i>
Renewal Period:	1 year (<i>may only be renewed twice & held for a total of 3 years</i>)
Renewal Requirements:	\$75 fee , a total of <i>not less than 200 CE hours by year two and 300 CE hours by year three, & a total of not less than 100 clinical supervision hours by year two and 200 clinical supervision hours by year three</i> or as necessary for application for initial application requirements for CADC-I, CADC-II, or CAADC within three years of beginning work in the field (<i>with not less than 50 clinical supervision hours in any calendar year the CADC-T is held</i>), whichever is greater
