



# Alcohol & Drug Abuse Certification Board of Georgia

## **CCJP (Certified Criminal Justice Professional)**

### Prerequisite credential

- Applicants must have a current CADC II or CAADC.

### CJ Education/Domains

- A total of **100 hours** of substance use disorder-specific education must be documented by copies of transcripts or certificates of attendance.
  - 6 hours of Dynamics of Addiction and Criminal Behavior
  - 6 hours of Legal, Ethical, and Professional Responsibility
  - 6 hours of Criminal Justice System and Processes
  - 6 hours of Clinical Evaluation: Screening and Assessment
  - 6 hours of Treatment Planning
  - 6 hours of Case Management, Monitoring, and Participant Supervision
  - 6 hours of Counseling
  - 6 hours of Documentation
  - 52 hours of any of the CCJP domains

### Direct Work Experience

- A total of 2,000 work experience hours must be documented. Experience hours must be directly related to the 8 performance domains

### Clinical Supervision

- The CCJP applicant must complete 100 hours of face-to-face clinical supervision across the eight (8) performance domains of the CCJP. Candidates must demonstrate a minimum of 20 total hours clinical supervision in each of the 4 performance domains.
  - Dynamics of Addiction & Criminal Behavior
  - Criminal Justice System & Processes
  - Screening, Assessment, and Treatment Planning
  - Case Management and Counseling
- Clinical supervision requirements are further defined to require that a minimum of 25% of clinical supervision hours be individual (one-on-one) supervision.

### Fees

- Application Fee \$150.00
- Examination Fee: \$180.00

### IC&RC Examination Level

- CCJP - Applicants must meet all requirements for the CCJP and pass the IC&RC CCJP examination

### Legal Scope of Practice

- As a CADC-II or CAADC is required, the scope of practice is detailed by the credential held. This credential demonstrates a proficiency in working with the Criminal Justice Population.

### Renewal

- Period - 2 years
- Renewal Requirements - \$150 fee, 40 Contact Hours of CE related to A&D. Three (3) hours must be in Legal, three (3) hours must be in Ethical Considerations, three (3) hours must be in professional responsibility, and 31 hours of general continuing education related to A&D and/or the Criminal Justice System.
