



# Alcohol & Drug Abuse Certification Board of Georgia

## **CPRC (Certified Peer Recovery Coach) - Reciprocal**

### Prerequisite formal education

- High School Diploma or GED

### PR Education/Domains

- A total of **100 hours** of classroom/workshop style education related to the competencies of CPRC must be documented by copies of transcripts or certificates of attendance.
  - 16 hours of Ethical Responsibility
  - 10 hours of Advocacy
  - 10 hours of Mentoring/Education
  - 10 hours of Recovery/Wellness Support
  - 54 hours remaining can be any training relevant to the competencies of CPRC

### Peer Recovery Coach Statement

- The applicant must document three (3) years ongoing and continuous years of recovery from alcohol and/or drugs. Documentation will be required through a personal Peer Recovery Coach statement

### Direct Work Experience

- A total of 500 hours of volunteer or paid supervised practical experience specific to the CPRC Domains is required. Defined as supervised paid or voluntary work experience in which the applicant has direct contact and responsibility for a caseload of individuals enrolled in treatment for a substance use disorder or co-occurring mental and substance use disorders

### Clinical Supervision

- The CPRC applicant must complete 50 hours of face-to-face supervision specific to the CPRC domains from an ADACBGA CCS, Non-CCS Approved Clinical Supervisor (ACS), and/or a CPRC.

### Fees

- Application Fee: \$150.00
- Examination Fee: \$180.00

### IC&RC Examination Level

- PR - Applicants must meet all requirements for the PR and pass the IC&RC PR examination

### Legal Scope of Practice

Promote recovery. Remove barriers. Connect people with recovery support services. Encourage hope, optimism, and healthy living.

### Renewal

- Period: 2 years
- Renewal Requirements: \$150 fee, 40 Contact Hours related to the peer recovery field and the 4 CPRC Domains. Ten (10) in professional ethics, 30 hours in professional education and development.
